FTNTT PERFORMANCE REVIEWS: The guidelines for the AY 2014-2015 Performance Reviews have been disseminated. Please note the following timeline:

January 2, 2015: FTNTT faculty members who have completed at least nine (9) years of consecutive appointments upload materials to FolioWeb for a Simplified Performance Review.

January 20, 2015: FTNTT faculty members who have completed three (3) or six (6) years of consecutive employment upload files to FolioWeb for a Full Performance Review.

FILE WORKSHOP The annual AAUP-KSU File Workshop will be held in November. The workshop will be segmented into two-day sessions. Invitations were sent on October 8.

FOLIOWEB UPDATE: An ad-hoc committee (with AAUP-KSU representation) has been formed to investigate a possible replacement to FolioWeb that could potentially be implemented as early as AY 2015-2016. AAUP-KSU suggests keeping back-up records of any and all documents on your FolioWeb profile.
